#### ***Adverse Drug Reactions in Canada***

Health Canada received 28,675 domestic adverse reaction cases in 2011, representing a 27.3% increase over 2010. The paediatric age group (<19 years) represented 6% of these cases.

The top 10 groups of all suspect health products were:

- Immunosuppressants
- Psycholeptics
- Drugs for treatment of bone diseases
- Psychoanaleptics
- Antineoplastic agents
- Analgesics
- Agents acting on the renin-angiotensin system
- Antithrombotic agents
- Antibacterials for systemic use
- Pituitary and hypothalamic hormones and analogues
